

### **GIII Instructions** Figure 1 **INSTALLING THE 250mL CAN STOP** 1. Remove the existing product from the column to be converted. 2. Remove the product stops currently in use for each column receiving a kit. 3. The setup for both front and rear columns is shown in figures 1, 2, and 3. Add spacers and stops in the following order (front to rear): **A**. 1.00" (25 mm) spacer B. 2.90" (74 mm) wide standard product stop C. 0.720" (18 mm) spacer Center Divider **D.** Anti-tilt plate E. 4.951" (126 mm) wide 250mL can stop F. 1.250" (32 mm) spacer G. 1.250" (32 mm) spacer Extrusions

3. While adjusting the product stops, remove the black anti-rotation pawl (dog) from each column that receives a kit.

## **INSTALLING THE PLASTIC EXTRUSION (Right Side)**

The rear extrusion is smaller than the front extrusion in order to allow sufficient clearance to install the part. The front extrusion is sized to run the entire height of the column. Do not load product past the top of the rear extrusion.

- The clip that runs along the outside of the extrusion is designed to engage either flange of the center-divider (channel). When fully engaged, it will snap past the hem at the leading edge of the channel's flange, providing a secure connection to the channel.
- 2. Once clipped into place, the extrusions should be slid downward so they rest on top of the new 250mL can stop(s).
- 3. Extrusion kits can be installed singularly or in pairs within the same column bay.
- 4. Adjust the retainers, and the vender is ready.

#### ADJUSTING PRODUCT RETAINERS

The procedure for adjusting the product retainers is different depending upon the serial number of the vender:

### GIII STACK (serial numbers beginning with 1503 and before):

- 1. In rear columns, use the standard rear retainer (backspacer). With the shim kit installed, slide the retainer forward as far as it will go, and engage the spring fingers on the right side into the right partition wall at position 9. Next, swing the left side of the retainer assembly forward so that the fingers on its left side engage the next pair of holes in the left column wall at position 10 (one position closer to the front of the vender). It is very important that the retainer be angled forward on the left side to prevent cans from catching the lip of the plastic extrusion as they approach the pivot.
- 2. In front columns, place the retainer in position 10.

## GIII STACK (serial numbers beginning with 1504 and after):

1. The column walls are slotted to accept front retainers in both the front

and rear columns; therefore, additional front retainers may be used as retainers for the rear columns. When a rear column is fitted with a 250mL shim kit, place a front retainer in position 10. The rear retainer (backspacer) can be pushed all the way to the back of the vender where it is out of the way.

2. In front columns, place the retainer in position 10.



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

## **Merlin RB Instructions**

Set right product retainer to position 15. Set selection depth to 3. Load cans three-deep. The top of the can may face toward the front or toward the rear of the vender, as long as all cans are loaded in the same direction. No kits or additional setup required. Capacity: 96 cans per column.

## Merlin IV Instructions (kits can be installed singularly or in pairs within the same column bay)


- 1. Remove the existing product from the column to be converted. Note: If converting from 1 Liter vender, it will be necessary to install a can filler (part number 256107 front column / 256108 rear column), then proceed with directions.
- Install the 240/250 mL can filler on left-hand side of column. (See Figure 4.)
- Install white plastic extrusion on left hand side of the column wall. Install the small extrusion on top of the long extrusion to ensure full capacity.


## When installing the white extrusion:


- a. The clip that runs along the outside of the extrusion is designed to engage either flange of the center-divider (channel). When fully engaged, it will snap past the hem at the leading edge of the channel's flange, providing a secure connection to the channel.
- **b.** Slide the white extrusion down until angle is flush with baffle

## **LEFT COLUMN WALL**

Install a black extrusion on the front right side retainer. See figure 5. Serial number 200422XX00001 and after: Adjust the front retainers to position 9. Set the rear retainer (back spacer) to 10 right / 9 left. **Prior to serial number 200422XX00001:** Adjust the front retainers to position 10. Set the rear retainer (backspacer) to 11 right / 10 left.

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

## **EZ Vender Instructions**


- Remove existing product from column that you intend to convert over to 240 mL / 250 mL cans.
- Remove the wiring cover plate from the front of the vend mechanism assembly (stack).
- Pull out the product stop holding rod.
- Remove the existing product stop, and replace it with the 240/250 mL product stop assembly from the kit. (See Figures 7 and 8.)
- Reinstall the product stop rod.
- Replace and secure the wiring cover plate.
- Install the 240/250 mL retainer (included in the kit) on one of the 240/250 mL fillers from the kit. Secure it with the two supplied screws. Only tighten the screws about three-quarters of the way in. (See Figure 9.)


## Figure 10.

- Install the 240/250 mL fillers in the vender. Install the filler without the retainer attached in position 48 on the left column wall. Install the filler with the retainer attached in position 18 on the left column wall. (See Figure 10.)


## Figure 11.

- Install the anti-friction sheets in the positions shown in Figure 11.
- 10. Place the right column retainer in position 17 on the right column wall.
- 11. Enter the vender's programming, and set "SdEP" to "3" for all selections vending the 240 mL / 250 mL can.
- 12. Load cans three-deep, with all cans facing one direction. Once the cans have been loaded, place the retainer in the vending position, as shown in Figure 12.


240/250 mL product stop assembly (goes in place of existing product stop on EZ Vender)

#### Figure 9. Installation of the 240/250 mL retainer.




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

Installing the fillers


Installing the anti-friction sheets

Retainer positions








#### Loading position

After the vender has been loaded with product, place the retainer so that the screw is in the slot to the left.

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
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
